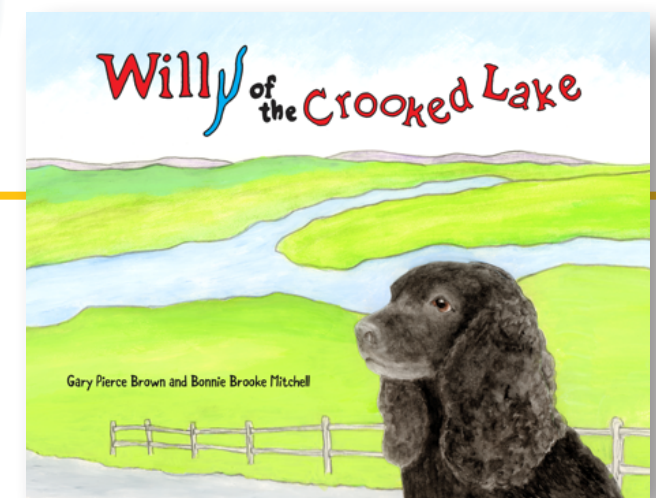

Willy Rescues the Finger Lakes SPCA

As reported in November, the Finger Lakes SPCA (FLSPCA) in Bath NY had been awarded \$25,000 through the Marion E. Cantwell Charitable Trust in Poughkeepsie, NY for the new shelter at River's Edge Farm. Additionally, the Cantwell Trustees challenged FLSPCA to raise another \$25,000 in order to have that matched by the Trust. We are pleased to announce that, through the overwhelming support of our community, the challenge has been met! As of January 18, 2016, \$42,283 has been received in response to the challenge, assuring FLSPCA the matching \$25,000.

Half of the money that was received to meet the challenge was due in large part to the distribution of the children's book, "Willy of the Crooked Lake," written by Hammondsport resident, Gary Brown, and illustrated by his dear friend, Bonnie Brooke Mitchell, of White Plains, NY.

"Willy of the Crooked Lake," is the true story of a black Cocker Spaniel that the Brown family rescued from the highway on Route 54 overlooking Keuka Lake. Gary and Bonnie have donated the book to the FLSPCA to raise money for the completion of the new shelter at River's Edge Farm. The farm currently houses the FLSPCA administrative office and is home to current programs like spay/neuter clinics, canine training, wellness clinics, and humane education that all strive to keep animals from populating shelters in the first place.

The book is available for a minimum donation of \$15 per book. It is available at book signings from time to time or from the FLSPCA, at both locations and on line via their web site: www.fingerlakesspca.org. It is also available to be read at local (continued)

libraries in Corning, Bath, Hammondsport and Howard and in the Hammondsport Public Schools. The books were just printed in early December, and already 500 books have been distributed, raising over \$12,000. "Needless to say, I am thrilled with the debut of the book!" says Gary Brown, the author.

Gary Brown's roots in Steuben County and the Finger Lakes run deep. He grew up in Corning and graduated from Corning Free Academy in 1962, when it was still a high school. Summers were always spent at his grandparents' cottage on Keuka Lake. He attended college in Ohio and then seminary in Manhattan after which he and his wife raised a family. Gary served as a pastor in three churches, concluding his ministry as Senior Pastor of the First Congregational Church in Stamford, CT for 27 years.

He and his wife, Martha, returned to the area in retirement to live on Keuka Lake, where his grandparents' cottage had stood. The proceeds raised from his book are dedicated in memory of his wife, Martha, who passed away in 2014. One of the real life dog rooms in the new shelter will be named in her memory.

"It has been one of my greatest pleasures to work with Gary on the distribution of 'Willy of the Crooked Lake', says Vicki Mosgrove, FLSPCA Executive Director. "Besides it being a successful fundraiser, the story of Willy does so much to teach compassion and empathy to young children, and that, to us, does much to prevent the potential of animal cruelty. We are very grateful to Gary and Bonnie for this gift."

A SWEET KITTEN HELPED BY KATIE'S FUND



"Myra"

Our lucky little girl, MYRA, was adopted in November of 2015. She was brought to us initially by a Good Samaritan who rescued her from wandering around a busy landfill. She was just a baby kitten and had a severe URI. Myra didn't stand a chance on her own. She ultimately developed a dangerously high temp. and needed immediate veterinary care to bring it down. Thanks to excellent veterinary care made possible by Katie's Fund, and lots of TLC from staff and volunteers, she is healthy, happy and now has a home!

Katie's Fund helps homeless cats, dogs and horses with special needs who without such assistance may otherwise go unadopted or wait a very long time for a loving home. Since the inception of Katie's fund in April of 2014, 56 special needs animals have benefited - 10 dogs, 45 cats and 1 Henny.

Since the start of this critical fund, and because of ongoing donations in support, over \$13,000 in medical care and other services have been provided to these special needs animals. As a result, more lives of significantly injured and/or ill animals have been saved, and overall adoptability for these animals increased, thereby reducing the length of stay at our shelter for the majority.

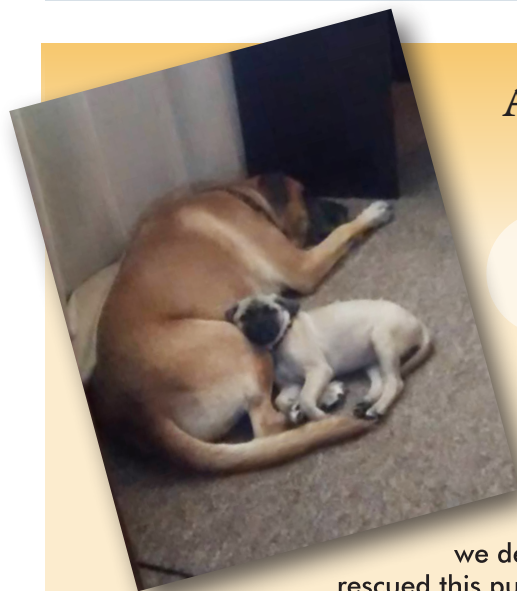


A HAPPY TAIL...

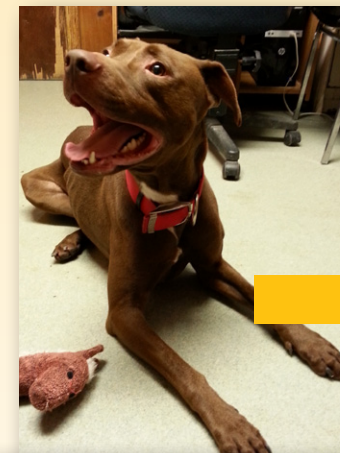
