The reason we do what we do is because we believe our innocent animal friends need and deserve protection and good care and because we recognize the extreme importance and specialness of the human-companion animal bond. The new shelter reflects our organization's values and will help us to better achieve our mission. We are so grateful we live in a community which shares and supports these same values.

We are so excited to invite the community to come in and visit the animals in their new home during our Grand Opening of the new shelter on Saturday, June 16th. Due to the astonishing generosity of the community, we are nearing 90% of our original capital campaign goal of \$2.6 million. These monies were raised primarily via large individual gifts for naming opportunities, grant and foundation funding, and *Willy of the Crooked Lake* book donations. We are so grateful for every single gift and the extraordinary support we have received from everyone to date.

At this time, we are continuing our River's Edge Community Campaign and invite anyone who has yet to give (or anyone who has given, but would like to provide additional assistance) to join us in giving as we draw ever nearer the completion of this vital project. While the interior of the new building is primarily finished, we still very much need our community's support. We cannot stress this enough.

We still need to complete the remaining balance of our campaign goal to cover paying off the property mortgage and to replenish the endowment. Additionally, we incurred some additional expense to move and reset fencing and for expanded fencing installation. We also are planning concrete pads and overhead cover for our outside dog exercise areas. These expenditures were not fully integrated into the initial capital campaign goal. While we made use of some of our existing fencing, expanded fencing was needed for the optimized well-being of our canine friends. (continued)

You can still be a part of this historic event and the successful completion of the campaign to ensure we are in a position to best provide for our community's homeless, abused and neglected animals. Special recognition opportunities are still available for gifts of varying sizes (please read to the end of this article for details). If you are a new donor, we are asking you to do a split gift or two gifts designating part for the new building fund and part for shelter operations.

Again, any gift, large or small, will bring us closer to achieving 100% of this critical goal!



VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

Craig German

Craig German was born in Binghamton and raised in Horseheads, New York. He grew up with his mom and dad, a sister, a half-sister and half-brother. After graduation from Horseheads High School, he enlisted in the U.S. Army in the field of Specialty Field Artillery. His first 2 years of service were spent in Baumholder, Germany, and his last two years were spent in Caran, Colorado. When he returned home to Horseheads Craig worked as a machinist for 30 years. After retiring he moved to Bath where he currently resides.

Last year Craig adopted a chocolate lab from a rescue. Her name is Pippa, and she spends all her time with Craig - walking, playing in the river, watching TV and doing chores at the FLSPCA. When helping with the acres and acres of lawn mowing, she prefers the riding mower to the push models.

Craig has many interests and hobbies including supporting the Miami Dolphins, the New York Yankees and Syracuse University football and basketball teams. He likes to read, bike, fish, camp and listen to classic rock music. When he is not volunteering at the FLSPCA, Craig volunteers each week at the Veteran's Administration working with inpatients.

Craig has been with us for 2 years this spring. His schedule ranges between 3-5 days a week depending on what he is called upon to do. His assignments are diverse, and he has the willingness and skill sets to do whatever is asked of him. Some of the jobs Craig does routinely are carpentry repairs, groundskeeping, gardening, garbage and recycles management, training and overseeing other volunteers, upkeep on grounds and barns, care of on-site animals and machinery repairs.

He has also made significant contributions in preparing for the opening of our new building They comprise helping to put in 3 acres of new lawn behind the new facility to be used for the dog play runs, landscaping the front entry yard, putting together new equipment

for use in the new building, and moving and cleaning dozens of stainless steel cat cages to be refurbished for the farm location.

He accompanies us on road trips to pick up hay, straw, donations and general supplies; not to mention numerous rides to the landfill with electronics, appliances and metal items for recycling. He has a very responsible nature mixed with a mature and professional attitude and works well with the public. An event that Craig particularly enjoyed was loading supplies and helping get them delivered to one of our equine foster care locations. He said it was a great experience seeing how a foster care program works and where some of our large animals are being cared for.

Craig's advice to others is to get involved with the SPCA because it feels good to help others out - both the animals in our care and the clients we work with.

VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

David Geis

David Geis was raised on a farm in Jasper until he was 12, at which point his family moved to Addison. He lived with his parents; a brother, Pete, and step-brother, Steve. After graduating from Addison High School, Dave enlisted in the U.S. Navy as a nuclear machinist mate. Presently, he lives in Bath and is attending Corning Community College where he is majoring in mechanical engineering. His studies keep him busy, and in addition to school he also has five daughters to raise. His girls are Jazlynne, age 13; Skyla, age 9; Rylee, age 8; Azarianna, age 4; and Davina, age 3.

When I asked what hobbies he has or things he likes to do in his "leisure time" he laughed and said, "What leisure time? I already mentioned that I have five daughters! "When he does find some down time he loves watching his favorite football team, the Buffalo Bills, or working on cars. Other interests include reading technical books and manuals, listening to alternative rock music, taking the girls to the park, picnicking, and camping. He attends all the FLSPCA events with his family and loves to have the girls with him supporting projects that are important in helping animals have better lives.

David has been with us for 2 years this spring. The list of his accomplishments is long and impressive: He does grounds maintenance, mechanical equipment repairs, landscaping, house and barn repairs, set-ups for fundraising events, assists with farm and domestic animal care, makes dump recycle runs, puts in our own barn hay, makes hay and supply runs to foster farms, picks up donations, makes Salvation Army drop-offs, and assists with the feral cat trapping program. Dave is not only very capable, he also has a very pleasant and professional demeanor when dealing with staff, other volunteers and the public.

Two of David's legacy projects are putting in 3 acres of grass lawn behind the new facility to be used for the dogs' play run; and secondly, he planned out, procured materials for and built an amazing 8' x 20' x 10' high wood and wire communal cat condo inside the barn. This structure allows several cats to be free from small cages and interact with each other. The cats have many shelves, ramps and ladders to keep them from being bored and give them the opportunity to get plenty of activity. Dave appropriately named his creation Dave's Cattyshack.



Special kudos to Dave's girls for their general help throughout many projects we have completed, but in particular the days of helping in the blistering sun by picking rocks and spreading grass seed and straw to see to it that the 3 acres of backyard look so beautiful today.

Dave says his most memorable experience at the shelter, besides the Cattyshack, is being able to bring his kids with him to help with activities of such importance. They have the chance to do good things themselves and meet others with similar values.

He says it has been exciting volunteering for us at the time when the new facility project was underway and actually contributing to the process of getting it completed. The new building has a historical value to the people and animals in the community, but for Dave it has a personal one as well.

Craig and Dave are both very special volunteers. They have been relentlessly hardworking and loyal to the FLSPCA for months and months. We could not have accomplished what we have without their efforts. They make a significant difference in the success of our mission every day that they show up to work. Additionally, along the way they add so much extra with their heartwarming personalities, friendship and sense of humor. We are thankful that they showed up on our doorstep and brought Pippa and the girls with them.

I think she also may have some "pointer" in her setter style background somewhere. 4 times I have seen her stand at attention to look at something outdoors and lift up her left front paw.

She obviously has the cats all herded to their respective areas, as well.

I didn't know I was getting such a "Working Girl", I thought she would be more of a "Foo-Foo" princess dog. She is quite the baby whenever my daughter is around; it is clear she is most attached to her in that way.

She had some trouble adjusting to David, but Vicki suggested that David be the one responsible for feeding her and be sure to walk her as well, and that is much better now.

Thank you for sending such a wonderful addition to our family. We are very much looking forward to including Miley into the "Happy Home".
