- 1. Return completed farm animal adoption application form and written letter of recommendation to our farm program personnel. Someone familiar with your farm animal experience should write the letter.
- 2. If a suitable animal becomes available, all qualified parties will be notified.
- 3. Make an appointment to meet and work with the animal.
- 4. Schedule a home visit to be completed by a staff member at FLSPCA to wherever the animal will be kept.
- 5. If potential adopter and FLSPCA staff are comfortable, the adoption is completed.

• Geese \$20.00 each

• Duck \$15.00 each

• Goats, Sheep and Pigs \$65.00 each

<sup>\*</sup>Animals may be transported from the FLSPCA to your home for a small donation. The distance traveled determines the amount.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Please note that (with rare exception) farm animals live in social groups and will not be adopted into situations where they will live alone. We place them where they will have a companion of their own kind to live with.
